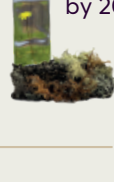

Its estate, spanning over 380 hectares of planted vineyards, lies between 980 and 1,100 meters above sea level. The vineyard is comprised of three unique terroirs that enjoy worldwide renown.

CHILE

Elqui Valley: Flowering desert

The Elqui Valley is located in northern Chile, alongside the Atacama Desert. The vines are planted just 25km from the ocean, so their growth is subject to a powerful maritime influence. Great Syrah is produced here.

Maipo Valley: Cabernet heartland

The wine region nearest to Santiago, Maipo is widely recognized as being among the best in Chile for producing Cabernet Sauvignon. It is also regarded as the birthplace of Chile's wine industry.

Casablanca Valley: The birthplace of Chile's finest white wines

The Casablanca Valley, located between Santiago and Valparaíso, is one of Chile's most renowned wine regions, known for its cool climate and proximity to the Pacific Ocean. This unique geographic setting allows for the influence of morning fogs and ocean breezes that moderate temperatures, creating ideal conditions for growing varieties such as Sauvignon Blanc, Chardonnay, and Pinot Noir.

Leyda Valley: Cool-coastal freshness

The Leyda Valley's location at less than 15km from the Pacific Ocean makes it the perfect place for growing Sauvignon Blanc and Pinot Noir. Leyda's cool-coastal climate, with its low temperatures and refreshing Pacific breezes, enables the grapes to ripen slowly.

Cachapoal Valley: Unique Expression

Nestling in the Andean foothills, this is the place where we produce iconic wines. The winds blow down the ravines in the afternoons, cooling the vineyards during the hottest part of the day. The volcanic soils here lend the wines a distinctive mouthfeel and unique character.

Colchagua Valley: Where Carmenere shines

This broad and highly diverse valley is located some 150km to the south of Santiago. Its Mediterranean climate means that the central part of Colchagua is warm, although the ocean has a certain level of influence on temperatures.

Curicó Valley: Consistency at is best

Protected by the Coastal Mountain Range and located 200km to the south of Santiago, this wine region lies in the southernmost part of Chile's Central Valley. It has a moderate climate with well-defined seasons.

Malleco Valley: Indigenous stamp

An extreme valley situated 600km to the south of Santiago, Malleco is home to most of Chile's indigenous communities. Here we discovered special conditions for producing Pinot Noir with a sense of place heightened by human touch.

Uco Valley: Mountain viticulture

Uco is among Argentina's best-known wine regions. Located in the Province of Mendoza, it is characterized by its dry continental climate with very warm days and cold nights (a thermal range of 16°C), enabling the grapes to ripen slowly. Malbec and Cabernet Franc really shine here.



Tourism Experiences



Casa Viñamar:

Located at the heart of the Casablanca Valley, just 45 minutes from Santiago is Casa Viñamar. Known as the house of sparkling wine, Casa Viñamar stands out for its broad range of wine tourism services designed for those who love still and sparkling wines. These are centered on the Macerado Bistró, a restaurant offering an original menu with local flavours.



Viña San Pedro:

Nestling in the foothills of the Andes Mountains, the San Pedro Cachapoal Andes winery is home to San Pedro's fine wines. Its tourism services are centred around wines that are the most representative and exclusive in Chile.



Viña Tarapacá:

Viña Tarapacá is located in the Maipo Valley and is the home of Tarapacá's wines. Visitors to the renowned manor house discover a range of food and wine that showcases the traditional and excellent wines, as well as tastings, tours and a wine store.



Finca La Celia:

Located in the historic heart of the Uco Valley, Finca La Celia invites visitors to experience over 130 years of winemaking heritage in an authentic countryside setting. Our heritage house, surrounded by vineyards and mountain views, is open to tourism and offers a unique immersion into the birthplace of Malbec in the region.
